I-80 westbound lane east of Madison Avenue closed during pavement repair project

(Council Bluffs, IA.— Sep 3, 2014) — Iowa DOT is improving I-80 westbound lanes just east of the Madison Avenue interchange in Council Bluffs. The current subsurface drainage system in this area has led to an uneven roadway surface and degradation of the pavement in this area.

To prevent this issue from reoccurring the existing pavement will be replaced and the subsurface drainage system will be improved. Construction is anticipated to begin in September 2014 and last two months. This project will result in I-80 westbound being reduced to one lane near Valley View and Mosquito Creek during construction.

Iowa DOT is working hard to keep the public informed of construction impacts and will actively seek opportunities to update the public regarding the project. Sign up to receive traffic alerts for the interstate routes that you use via Iowa DOT's 511 Traveler Information site.

Iowa DOT is in the process of reconstructing I-80, I-29 and I-480 in the Council Bluffs metropolitan area as part of the Council Bluffs Interstate Improvement Program. This comprehensive interstate redesign, which will be delivered over the next eight to 10 years, will modernize the highway system and improve mobility and safety of approximately 18 miles of interstate.
