### IA 192/South Expressway northbound lane closure in place for three weeks

(Council Bluffs, IA.— Aug 5, 2014) — Traffic on northbound IA 192/South Expressway between I-80/I-29 and 23rd Avenue was reduced to one lane on Monday, August 4 for three weeks. The lane closure is needed while a utility company relocates a segment of a gas distribution line. The relocated gas line will allow new stormwater pipes to be installed that will help manage stormwater from the interstate reconstruction projects. Northbound traffic will be reduced to one lane near the interstate. Interstate access will not be affected.

Construction projects in this area are part of the Council Bluffs Interstate System Improvement Program, which is a large scale modernization and rehabilitation of the interstate system. Iowa DOT is committed to completing the interstate improvements with minimal inconvenience to the public. Additionally, the DOT is committed to keeping the traveling public informed of the construction project impacts in a timely and accurate manner.
