### Harry Langdon Boulevard closed for the weekend

(Council Bluffs, IA – October 13, 2016) – Beginning at 6:00 a.m. on Saturday, October 15th, construction crews will close Harry Langdon Boulevard to through traffic from Woodbury Avenue to U.S. 275/Iowa 92 to set girders for the future westbound I-80 bridge. Harry Langdon is expected to be reopened to traffic on Monday, October 17th, by 6 a.m. Access will be maintained to property owners living along Harry Langdon Boulevard throughout the closure. Harry Langdon Boulevard will also be closed overnight on Monday, October 17, and Tuesday, October 18, from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Iowa DOT is in the process of reconstructing I-80, I-29 and I-480 in the Council Bluffs metropolitan area. This comprehensive interstate redesign will modernize the highway system and improve mobility and safety of approximately 18 miles of interstate. Motorists are encouraged to allow for extra travel time while this interstate improvement takes effect.
