### Interstate closures will impact drivers over the next two weeks

(Council Bluffs, IA – November 1, 2017) – Beginning Sunday night, November 5, drivers may encounter interstate closures in Council Bluffs when construction crews close portions of I-80 and I-29. On Sunday, November 5, I-29 southbound between 9th Ave and Nebraska Ave will be closed for 4 days starting at 10:30 pm for demolition of part of the UPRR Bridge. I-29 northbound will be closed on Sunday, November 12, also for 4 days. Drivers are encouraged to use I-480 as a detour. See attachment for details and detours.

I-80 eastbound and westbound will be closed at the I-80/I-29 interchange (Exit 1) on Sunday, November 5, from 10 pm to 1 am and nightly Tuesday through Thursday from 10 pm to 6 am for bridge construction.






