

Overnight Lane Closures on I-80 in Omaha

OMAHA, Nebraska – May 7, 2020 – TONIGHT, Thursday May 7, from 7 p.m. to midnight, the left lane of westbound Interstate 80 will close between Interstate 480/U.S. 75 and the Missouri River Bridge into Iowa for overnight construction work. Traffic will be able to use remaining open lanes.

This work is part of Iowa DOT's process of reconstructing I-80, I-29 and I-480 in the Council Bluffs metropolitan area. If you would like more information about this construction visit the program website, www.CouncilBluffsInterstate.iowaDOT.gov.

Nebraska DOT reminds motorists to drive with caution, obey the posted speed limit and other signs in the work area. Be aware that traffic fines for moving violations are at least double in work zones. As in all work zones, drivers should stay alert, allow ample space between vehicles, and wear seat belts.
