### **Traffic Signals Down at Intersection of Iowa 92 and Harry Langdon Blvd/Wabash Ave; Expect Significant Traffic Delays During Peak Times**

(Council Bluffs, IA.— March 2, 2015) Due to an earlier accident, the temporary traffic signals are down at the intersection of Iowa 92 and Harry Langdon Blvd/Wabash Ave. Traffic is currently directed to an all-way stop and significant delays are expected during peak times. Repairs to the traffic signal are currently anticipated between 48 hours to 72 hours. Local traffic is urged to take an alternate route, if possible. More information will be made available as it arises.

Iowa DOT is in the process of reconstructing I-80, I-29 and I-480 in the Council Bluffs metropolitan area as part of the Council Bluffs Interstate Improvement Program. This comprehensive interstate redesign, which will be delivered over the next eight to 10 years, will modernize the highway system and improve mobility and safety of approximately 18 miles of interstate.
