South Expressway Exit Ramp Closed for 30 Days


(Council Bluffs, IA – July 5, 2017) – The East System Interchange Phase II reconstruction is currently underway and is scheduled to be complete in 2018. On Monday, July 10, construction crews will close the I-80 westbound/I-29 northbound exit to South Expressway (Exit 3) at 6 a.m. The exit ramp will be closed for approximately 30 days while the ramp is connected to the future interstate alignment.

The project includes reconstruction of I-80 westbound, just west of Madison Avenue to South Expressway, including portions of the South Expressway and Madison Avenue interchanges in Council Bluffs. The project also includes the I-80 westbound to I-29 southbound flyover ramp.




